

SENATE BILL NO. 796

December 14, 2021, Introduced by Senators NESBITT and HERTEL and referred to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure.

A bill to amend 1945 PA 327, entitled
"Aeronautics code of the state of Michigan,"
(MCL 259.1 to 259.208) by adding section 206a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 206a. (1) Except as authorized by law, a county, city,
2 village, or township shall not enact or adopt an ordinance, policy,
3 or rule that relates to the ownership or operation of an advanced
4 air mobility aircraft or advanced air mobility and shall not
5 otherwise engage in the regulation or ownership of an advanced air
6 mobility aircraft or advanced air mobility. Any ordinance, policy,
7 or rule that violates this subsection, whether enacted or adopted

1 by the county, city, village, or township before or after the
2 effective date of this section, is void.

3 (2) As used in this section, "advanced air mobility" means a
4 system that transports people and property by air between points in
5 the United States using aircraft, including electric aircraft and
6 electric vertical takeoff and landing aircraft, in both controlled
7 and uncontrolled airspace.
