THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 17a. (1) To facilitate continued access to markets for nursery stock, the department may do 1 or both of the following:
- 3 (a) At the request of a nursery dealer, nursery grower, or 4 plant grower or based upon records voluntarily supplied by a
- 5 nursery dealer, nursery grower, or plant grower, inspect, audit, or

- 1 certify nurseries in this state.
- 2 (b) Issue certificates of free sale under subsection (3).
- 3 (2) A nursery dealer, nursery grower, or plant grower shall
- 4 submit an application for a certificate of free sale on a form and
- 5 in a manner prescribed by the department.
- 6 (3) The department shall grant or deny an application for a
- 7 certificate of free sale within 10 business days after the
- 8 department receives a completed application under subsection (2)
- 9 and the application fee under subsection (4). If the department
- 10 determines that the application meets the requirements of this act

- 12 issue a certificate of free sale. If the department determines that
