

HOUSE BILL NO. 4120

February 03, 2021, Introduced by Rep. Brann and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled
"The Michigan penal code,"
(MCL 750.1 to 750.568) by adding section 411y.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 **Sec. 411y. (1) A person who sets a contraption or device that**
2 **is intentionally made or set in a manner that renders the**
3 **contraption or device capable of causing injury or death to an**
4 **individual and who leaves, or permits that contraption or device to**
5 **be left, in or about any place that other individuals may come into**

1 contact with that device is guilty of a felony punishable by
2 imprisonment for not more than 2 years or a fine of not more than
3 \$1,000.00, or both.

4 (2) A person who violates subsection (1) and by that violation
5 causes the injury of another individual is guilty of a felony
6 punishable by imprisonment for not more than 5 years or a fine of
7 not more than \$5,000.00, or both.

8 (3) A person who violates subsection (1) and by that violation
9 causes the serious impairment of a body function of another
10 individual is guilty of a felony punishable by imprisonment for not
11 more than 10 years or a fine of not more than \$7,500.00, or both.
12 As used in this subsection, "serious impairment of a body function"
13 means that term as defined in section 58c of the Michigan vehicle
14 code, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.58c.

15 (4) A person who violates subsection (1) and by that violation
16 causes the death of another individual is guilty of a felony
17 punishable by imprisonment for not more than 15 years or a fine of
18 not more than \$10,000.00, or both.

19 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
20 after the date it is enacted into law.
