## **HOUSE BILL NO. 4126**

February 04, 2021, Introduced by Reps. Howell, Eisen and Cherry and referred to the Committee on Natural Resources and Outdoor Recreation.

A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled "Natural resources and environmental protection act," by amending section 43525c (MCL 324.43525c), as added by 2020 PA 262.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 43525c. (1) Except as otherwise provided in this section,
- 2 an individual 18 years of age or older shall not hunt pheasants
- 3 without a current annual pheasant hunting license issued by this
- 4 state. The annual pheasant hunting license requirement is in

- 1 addition to the requirements for a base license. The fee for the
- 2 pheasant hunting license is \$25.00. The following individuals are
- 3 not required to obtain an annual pheasant hunting license under
- 4 this section:
- 5 (a) An individual only hunting pheasants at a game bird
- 6 hunting preserve licensed under part 417.
- 7 (b) An individual hunting pheasants on private land, except
- 8 for individuals hunting on land enrolled in the hunting access
- 9 program.
- 10 (c) An individual hunting pheasants on public land in the
- 11 Upper Peninsula.
- 12 (d) An individual who holds a lifetime small game license,
- 13 lifetime sportsperson's license, or a comprehensive lifetime
- 14 hunting and fishing license issued under section 44102.
- 15 (2) If issued as a stamp, a pheasant hunting license must be
- 16 affixed to the base license of the individual and signed across the
- 17 face of the stamp by the individual to whom it is issued.
- 18 (3) A collector may purchase a pheasant hunting license, if it
- 19 is issued as a stamp, without being required to place it on a base
- 20 license, sign across its face, or provide proof of competency under
- 21 section 43520(2). However, a license described in this subsection
- 22 is not valid for hunting pheasants.
- 23 (4) From Except as provided in sections 43541 and 43555, the
- 24 department shall deposit the fee collected for each pheasant
- 25 hunting license , the department shall deposit 100% of each license
- 26 fee—in the pheasant subaccount of the game and fish protection
- 27 account for the purposes stated in subsection (5).
- 28 (5) The pheasant subaccount is created in the game and fish
- 29 protection account. The state treasurer may receive money or other

- 1 assets from any source for deposit into the subaccount. The state
- 2 treasurer shall direct the investment of the subaccount. The state
- 3 treasurer shall credit to the subaccount interest and earnings from
- 4 subaccount investments. Money in the subaccount at the close of the
- 5 fiscal year remains in the subaccount and does not lapse to the
- 6 game and fish protection account or the general fund. Money in the
- 7 subaccount on January 1, 2026 is transferred to the game and fish
- 8 protection account. The department is the administrator of the
- 9 subaccount for auditing purposes. The department shall expend money
- 10 from the subaccount, upon appropriation, only to release live
- 11 pheasants on state-owned land suitable for pheasants.
- 12 (6) This section is repealed effective January 1, 2026.
