A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled "Natural resources and environmental protection act," by amending section 80141 (MCL 324.80141), as amended by 2018 PA 400.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 80141. (1) In addition to the requirements of subsection
- 2 (2), a person less than 12 years of age shall not operate a
- 3 motorboat that is powered by a motor or motors totaling more than 6

- 6 (b) The motorboat is powered by a motor or motors totaling no
  7 not more than 35 horsepower.
- 8 (2) Subject to subsection (4), a A person born on or after
- 9 July 1, 1996 shall not operate a motorboat that is powered by a
- 10 motor or motors totaling more than 6 horsepower on the waters of
- 11 this state unless the person has been issued a boating safety
- 12 certificate.
- 13 (3) A person operating or supervising the operation of a
- 14 motorboat as described in this section shall present the boating
- 15 safety certificate issued to him or her or, at the person's option,
- 16 an electronic copy, in a format approved by the department, of a
- 17 boating safety certificate issued to him or her, upon the demand of
