

# HOUSE BILL NO. 4150

February 04, 2021, Introduced by Reps. Glenn and Filler and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled  
"Michigan vehicle code,"  
by amending section 802 (MCL 257.802), as amended by 2019 PA 88.

## **THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:**

1       Sec. 802. (1) For a special registration issued under section  
2       226(8), the registrant shall pay 1/2 the tax imposed under section  
3       801 and a service fee of \$10.00.

4       (2) For all commercial vehicles registered after August 31 for  
5       the period expiring the last day of February, the secretary of

1 state shall collect a tax of  $1/2$  the rate otherwise imposed under  
2 this act. This subsection does not apply to vehicles registered by  
3 manufacturers or dealers under sections 244 to 247.

4 (3) For each special registration under section 226(9), the  
5 secretary of state shall collect a service fee of \$10.00.

6 (4) For temporary registration plates or markers under section  
7 226a(1), the secretary of state shall collect a service fee in an  
8 amount determined by the secretary of state to reflect the actual  
9 cost of administering the temporary registration plates and markers  
10 program, or in the amount of \$4.00 per plate or marker, whichever  
11 is less.

12 (5) For a temporary registration under section 226b, the fee  
13 is either of the following:

14 (a) For a 30-day temporary registration,  $1/10$  of the tax  
15 prescribed under section 801 or \$20.00, whichever is greater, and  
16 an additional \$10.00 service fee.

17 (b) For a 60-day temporary registration,  $1/5$  of the tax  
18 prescribed under section 801 or \$40.00, whichever is greater, and  
19 an additional \$10.00 service fee.

20 (6) For registration plates as provided for in section  
21 226a(5), (6), and (7), the secretary of state shall collect a  
22 service fee of \$40.00 for 2 registration plates and \$20.00 for each  
23 additional registration plate.

24 (7) For special registrations issued for special mobile  
25 equipment as provided in section 216(d), the secretary of state  
26 shall collect a service fee of \$15.00 each for the first 3 special  
27 registrations, and \$5.00 for each special registration issued in  
28 excess of the first 3.

29 (8) The secretary of state, upon request, may issue a

1 registration valid for 3 months for use on a vehicle with an  
2 elected gross weight of 24,000 pounds or greater on the payment of  
3 1/4 the tax provided in section 801(1)(k) and a service fee of  
4 \$10.00.

5 (9) Upon application to the secretary of state, an owner of a  
6 truck, truck tractor, or road tractor that is used exclusively for  
7 the purpose of gratuitously transporting farm crops or livestock  
8 bedding between the field where produced and the place of storage,  
9 feed from on-farm storage to an on-farm feeding site, or  
10 fertilizer, seed, or spray material from the farm location to the  
11 field may obtain a special registration. **A person who obtains a**  
12 **special registration under this subsection shall use the motor**  
13 **vehicle exclusively for the purposes described in this subsection.**  
14 **A person who violates this subsection is responsible for a civil**  
15 **infraction.** The service fee for each special registration issued  
16 under this subsection is \$20.00. The special registration is valid  
17 for a period of up to 12 months and expires on December 31. As used  
18 in this subsection:

19 (a) "Feed" means hay or silage.

20 (b) "Livestock bedding" means straw, sawdust, or sand.

21 (10) The secretary of state, upon request, may issue a special  
22 registration valid for 3 or more months for a road tractor, truck,  
23 or truck tractor owned by a farmer, if the motor vehicle is used  
24 exclusively in connection with the farmer's farming operations or  
25 for the transportation of the farmer and the farmer's family and  
26 not used for hire. **A person who obtains a special registration**  
27 **under this subsection shall use the motor vehicle exclusively for**  
28 **the purposes described in this subsection. A person who violates**  
29 **this subsection is responsible for a civil infraction.** The fee for

1 the registration is 1/10 of the tax provided in section 801(1)(c)  
2 times the number of months for which the special registration is  
3 requested and, in addition, a service fee of \$10.00. The secretary  
4 of state shall not issue a special registration for a motor vehicle  
5 for which the tax under section 801(1)(c) would be less than  
6 \$50.00.

7 (11) The secretary of state, upon request, may issue a  
8 registration valid for 3 months or more for use on a vehicle with  
9 an elected gross weight of 24,000 pounds or greater. The fee for  
10 the registration shall be 1/12 of the tax provided in section  
11 801(1)(k), times the number of months for which the special  
12 registration is requested and, in addition, a service fee of  
13 \$10.00.

14 (12) The secretary of state shall deposit the service fees  
15 collected under subsections (1), (3), (4), (5), (6), (7), (8), (9),  
16 (10), and (11) in the transportation administration collection fund  
17 created in section 810b through October 1, 2023.

18 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect  
19 unless Senate Bill No. \_\_\_\_ or House Bill No. 4153 (request no.  
20 01303'21) of the 101st Legislature is enacted into law.
