- 2 or younger shall have available on-site and utilize a SIDS
- 3 prevention monitor or home apnea monitor that monitors and tracks
- 4 the breathing and heart rate of sleeping infants for each infant
- 5 who is 9 months of age or younger in its care.
- 6 (2) As used in this section, "SIDS" means sudden infant death
- 7 syndrome.
