## **HOUSE BILL NO. 4626**

A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled "Natural resources and environmental protection act," by amending section 2154 (MCL 324.2154), as amended by 2018 PA 239.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 2154. (1) The By December 1 each year, the treasurer or other officer charged with the collection of taxes for an assessing district shall annually forward to the respective county a single statement of the assessment of all property for which payment is claimed under this subpart to the respective county by December 1.

- 4 (ii) The balance of any payment remaining after the charge made5 in subparagraph (i) shall be charged as follows:
- 6 (A) Not more than 50% from restricted revenue sources of the department of natural resources.
- 8 (B) The remaining balance after the charge under sub-9 subparagraph (A), from the general fund.
- 10 (b) If the property for which payment is claimed was purchased 11 with funds from the Michigan natural resources trust fund, the 12 payment shall be charged against the Michigan natural resources 13 trust fund.
- 14 (3) Beginning 2013, this state shall make payment in full to 15 all local assessing districts under this section. Beginning 2014, 16 if this state does not make payment in full to all local assessing 17 districts, the delinquent amount that this state failed to pay is 18 subject to penalty and interest as for delinquent taxes under the 19 general property tax act, 1893 PA 206, MCL 211.1 to 211.155.
- 20 (4) As used in this section, "Michigan natural resources trust fund" means the Michigan natural resources trust fund established in section 35 of article IX of the state constitution of 1963 and provided for in section 1902.
