A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled "Michigan vehicle code,"

by amending sections 654 and 698a (MCL 257.654 and 257.698a).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 654. (1) A motor vehicle forming part of a funeral
- 2 procession, when going to a place of burial, shall have has the
- 3 right of way over all other vehicles, except fire apparatus,
- 4 ambulances, and police patrol vehicles, at a street or highway
- 5 intersection within this state if the vehicle in the funeral

- 1 procession displays meets both of the following requirements:
- 2 (a) Displays a flag which shall be that is fluorescent orange
- 3 in color, and upon on which shall be is printed, stamped, or
- 4 stained a black cross, the star of David, or the crescent and star.
- 5 The lead vehicle and the last vehicle in the funeral procession may
- 6 carry an additional flag. The flags shall-must not contain a name
- 7 embossed or printed on the flag, except the word "funeral".
- 8 (b) Activates the hazard warning lights described in section
- 9 698a or the flashing, rotating, or oscillating purple or amber
- 10 lights described in section 698(5)(g).
- (2) A person passing through a funeral procession of motorvehicles, designated pursuant to subsection (1), with a vehicle of
- 13 any kind, is responsible for a civil infraction.
- Sec. 698a. (1) Any A vehicle may be equipped with lamps which
- 15 that may be used for the purpose of warning to warn the operators
- 16 of other vehicles of the presence of a vehicular traffic hazard
- 17 requiring the exercise of unusual care in approaching, overtaking,
- 18 or passing, and when so equipped may display such that warning in
- 19 addition to any other warning signals required by this act. The
- 20 lamps used to display such the warning to the front shall must be
- 21 mounted at the same level and as widely spaced laterally as
- 22 practicable, and shall must display simultaneously flashing white
- 23 or amber lights, or any shade of color between white and amber. The
- 24 lamps used to display such the warning to the rear shall must be
- 25 mounted at the same level and as widely spaced laterally as
- 26 practicable, and shall must show simultaneously flashing amber or
- 27 red lights, or any shade of color between amber and red. These
- 28 hazard warning lights shall must be visible from a distance of not
- 29 less than 500 feet under normal atmospheric conditions at night.

- 1 (2) A vehicle engaged in leading or escorting a funeral 2 procession or any vehicle that is part of a funeral procession may 3 activate the hazard warning lights described in subsection (1) 4 during the funeral procession.
- 5 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 6 after the date it is enacted into law.
