THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 311. (1) No-Except as provided in subsection (2),
- 2 compensation shall be must not be paid under this act for any
- 3 injury which that does not incapacitate the employee from earning
- 4 full wages, for a period of at least 1 week, but if incapacity
- 5 extends beyond the period of 1 week, compensation shall begin

- 1 begins on the eighth day after the injury. If incapacity continues
- 2 for 2 weeks or longer or if death results from the injury,
- 3 compensation shall must be computed from the date of the injury.
- 4 (2) Subsection (1) does not apply to a COVID-19-related 5 disease, illness, or injury.
- 6 (3) As used in this section, "COVID-19" means the disease
- 7 caused by the novel coronavirus identified as SARS-CoV-2 or a virus
- 8 mutating from SARS-CoV-2.
