A bill to amend 1976 PA 390, entitled "Emergency management act,"

by amending section 5 (MCL 30.405), as amended by 2006 PA 545.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 5. (1) In addition to the general authority granted to 2 the governor by this act, the governor may, upon the declaration of
- 3 a state of disaster or a state of emergency do 1 or more of the
- 4 following:
- 5 (a) Suspend a regulatory statute, order, or rule prescribing

- 1 the procedures for conduct of state business, when strict
- 2 compliance with the statute, order, or rule would prevent, hinder,
- 3 or delay necessary action in coping with the disaster or emergency.
- 4 This power does not extend to the suspension of criminal process
- 5 and procedures.
- **6** (b) Utilize the available resources of the state and its
- 7 political subdivisions, and those of the federal government made
- 8 available to the state, as are reasonably necessary to cope with
- 9 the disaster or emergency.
- 10 (c) Transfer the direction, personnel, or functions of state
- 11 departments, agencies, or units thereof for the purpose of
- 12 performing or facilitating emergency management.
- 13 (d) Subject to appropriate compensation, as authorized by the
- 14 legislature, commandeer or utilize private property necessary to
- 15 cope with the disaster or emergency.
- 16 (e) Direct and compel the evacuation of all or part of the
- 17 population from a stricken or threatened area within the state if
- 18 necessary for the preservation of life or other mitigation,
- 19 response, or recovery activities.
- 20 (f) Prescribe routes, modes, and destination of transportation
- 21 in connection with an evacuation.
- 22 (q) Control ingress and egress to and from a stricken or
- 23 threatened area, removal of persons within the area, and the
- 24 occupancy of premises within the area.
- 25 (h) Suspend or limit the sale, dispensing, or transportation
- 26 of alcoholic beverages, explosives, and combustibles.
- 27 (i) Provide for the availability and use of temporary
- 28 emergency housing.
- 29 (j) Direct all other actions which are necessary and

- 2 (2) Subsection (1) does not authorize any of the following:
- 3 (a) The seizure, taking, or confiscation of lawfully possessed4 firearms or ammunition.
 - (b) Banning the sale or purchase of firearms or ammunition.

 7 the implementation of a rule, order, or directive issued by the
 8 governor pursuant to under this section is guilty of a misdemeanor.
