THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 206b. (1) A zoning ordinance may make the rental of a dwelling in a residential district, including, but not limited to,
- 2 dwelling in a residential district, including, but not limited to 3 short-term rental, subject to a special use or conditional use
- 4 permit or procedure similar to that required for other commercial
- 5 uses in a residential district.

- 1 (2) For the purposes of zoning, all of the following apply to 2 short-term rental:
- 3 (a) If the total number of days of short-term rental of the 4 single-family residence, dwelling unit in a 1- to 4-family house, 5 or unit or group of units in a condominium during a calendar year
- 6 is 14 or less, it is a residential use of property and a permitted
- 7 use in all residential zones.
