A bill to prohibit the receipt of certain military weapons from the federal government by law enforcement agencies; and to provide for the powers and duties of certain state and local governmental officers and entities.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 1. As used in this act, "law enforcement agency" means that term as defined in section 2 of the Michigan commission on law enforcement standards act, 1965 PA 203, MCL 28.602.
- 4 Sec. 3. (1) A law enforcement agency may not receive any of

- 1 the following military weapons from a military equipment surplus
- 2 program operated by the federal government:
- 3 (a) Drones that are either armored or weaponized, or both.
- 4 (b) Aircraft that are combat configured or combat coded.
- 5 (c) Grenades, grenade launchers, or similar explosives.
- 6 (d) Silencers.
- 7 (e) Military armored vehicles.
- 8 (2) Notwithstanding subsection (1), a law enforcement agency
- 9 shall not receive a military weapon from a military equipment
- 10 surplus program operated by the federal government unless the
- 11 military weapon is nonlethal.
