HOUSE BILL NO. 5071

June 17, 2021, Introduced by Rep. Slagh and referred to the Committee on Transportation.

A bill to amend 2008 PA 23, entitled

"Enhanced driver license and enhanced official state personal identification card act,"

by amending section 6 (MCL 28.306), as amended by 2020 PA 374.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 6. (1) An application for an original enhanced driver license or enhanced official state personal identification card must be accompanied by payment of a fee of not more than \$50.00.
- 4 (2) The renewal fee for an enhanced driver license or enhanced 5 official state personal identification card renewed under this act

- 1 must be not more than \$50.00. However, Subject to subsection (9),
- 2 if an enhanced driver license or enhanced official state personal
- 3 identification card is expired at the time of renewal, the fee must
- 4 be the same as the fee provided under subsection (1). If the
- 5 secretary of state receives an application to renew an enhanced
- 6 driver license or enhanced official state personal identification
- 7 card that expires on or after March 1, 2020 before March 31, 2021,
- 8 the secretary of state shall process the application as a renewal
- 9 of an existing enhanced driver license or enhanced official state
- 10 personal identification card.
- 11 (3) Money from fees collected under subsections (1) and (2)
- 12 must be deposited into the enhanced driver license and enhanced
- 13 official state personal identification card fund created in section
- 7 after distribution as follows:
- 15 (a) The secretary of state shall refund to each county or
- 16 municipality acting as an examining officer or examining bureau
- 17 \$2.50 for each applicant examined for an original enhanced driver
- 18 license, if the application is not denied and the money refunded is
- 19 paid to the county or local treasurer and is appropriated to the
- 20 county, municipality, or officer or bureau receiving the money for
- 21 the purpose of carrying out this act.
- 22 (b) The state treasurer shall deposit the sum of \$4.00 to the
- 23 traffic law enforcement and safety fund created in section 819a of
- 24 the Michigan vehicle code, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.819a, for each
- 25 person examined for an original or renewal enhanced driver license.
- 26 (c) Four dollars and 50 cents of an original enhanced driver
- 27 license and \$6.00 of a renewal enhanced driver license must be
- 28 appropriated to the transportation economic development fund
- 29 established in section 2 of 1987 PA 231, MCL 247.902, and must not

- 1 be appropriated for any other purpose in any act making
- 2 appropriations of state funds.
- 3 (d) The money remaining after distributions are made under
- 4 subdivisions (a) through (c) must remain in the enhanced driver
- 5 license and enhanced official state personal identification card
- 6 fund created under section 7.
- 7 (4) The secretary of state may assess a fee for issuing a
- 8 duplicate or corrected enhanced driver license or enhanced official
- 9 state personal identification card. A fee assessed under this
- 10 subsection must not exceed the following amounts:
- 11 (a) Thirty dollars for an enhanced driver license that is an
- 12 operator's license.
- 13 (b) Forty dollars for an enhanced driver license that is a
- 14 chauffeur's license.
- 15 (c) Thirty dollars for an enhanced official state personal
- 16 identification card.
- 17 (5) A fee must not be charged under subsection (4) for a
- 18 change of address, to correct a departmental error, or to add or
- 19 remove a heart insignia described in section 310 of the Michigan
- 20 vehicle code, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.310.
- 21 (6) Fees collected under subsection (4) must be deposited to
- 22 the enhanced driver license and enhanced official state personal
- 23 identification card fund created under section 7.
- 24 (7) \mathbb{A} -Subject to subsection (9), a fee paid under this section
- 25 is nonrefundable, except for administrative error.
- 26 (8) The secretary of state shall not assess a late renewal fee
- 27 for an enhanced driver license or enhanced official state personal
- 28 identification card that expires on or after March 1, 2020 and is
- 29 renewed before March 31, 2021.

- (9) Beginning March 31, 2021, if an enhanced driver license or enhanced official state personal identification card is expired at the time of the renewal, the department shall charge the applicant the renewal fee or upon request shall reimburse the applicant the difference between the renewal fee and the late renewal fee charged and collected if both of the following apply:
 - (a) The applicant registered for an in-person enhanced driver license or enhanced official state personal identification card renewal appointment before the expiration date.

- 10 (b) The enhanced driver license or enhanced official state
 11 personal identification card has not been expired for more than 90
 12 days.
- Enacting section 1. Section 6 of the enhanced driver license and enhanced official state personal identification card act, 2008 PA 23, MCL 28.306, as amended by this amendatory act, is intended to be retroactive and apply retroactively to fees charged on or after March 31, 2021.
