## **HOUSE BILL NO. 5134**

June 24, 2021, Introduced by Rep. Martin and referred to the Committee on Government Operations.

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled "Michigan vehicle code,"

by amending section 629e (MCL 257.629e), as amended by 2003 PA 73.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 629e. (1) Before October 1, 2003, in addition to any fine
- 2 or cost ordered to be paid under this act, and in addition to any
- 3 assessment levied under section 907, the judge or district court
- 4 magistrate shall levy a highway safety assessment of \$5.00, a jail
- 5 reimbursement program assessment of \$5.00, and a secondary road

- 1 patrol and training assessment of \$10.00 for each civil infraction
- 2 determination except for a parking violation or a violation for
- 3 which the total fine and costs imposed are \$10.00 or less. Upon
- 4 payment of the assessments, the clerk of the court shall transmit
- 5 the assessments levied to the department of treasury. Until October
- 6 1, 2003, the state treasurer shall deposit the revenue received
- 7 pursuant to under this subsection in the highway safety fund, in
- 8 the jail reimbursement program fund, and in the secondary road
- 9 patrol and training fund, and shall report annually to the
- 10 legislature all revenues received and disbursed under this section.
- 11 An assessment levied under this subsection shall—is not be
- 12 considered a civil fine for purposes of section 909.
- 13 (2) A highway safety fund, a jail reimbursement program fund,
- 14 and a secondary road patrol and training fund are created in the
- 15 department of treasury. The highway safety fund and the secondary
- 16 road patrol and training fund shall must be administered by the
- 17 department of state police. The jail reimbursement program fund
- 18 shall must be administered by the department of corrections. Until
- 19 October 1, 2003, money collected under subsection (1) shall must be
- 20 deposited in the respective funds as provided in subsection (1).
- 21 Beginning October 1, 2003, money collected under subsection (1)
- 22 shall must be deposited in the justice system fund created in
- 23 section 181 of the revised judicature act of 1961, 1961 PA 236, MCL
- 24 600.181. Money remaining in the respective funds at the end of a
- 25 fiscal year shall does not lapse to the general fund, but shall
- 26 remain-remains in the respective funds for use for the purposes of
- 27 the respective funds. The money deposited in the highway safety
- 28 fund shall serve serves as a supplement to, and not as a
- 29 replacement for, the funds money budgeted for the department of

- 1 state police. The money in the highway safety fund shall must be
- 2 used by the department of state police for the employment of
- 3 additional state police enlisted personnel to enforce the traffic
- 4 laws on the highways and freeways of this state. The money in the
- 5 jail reimbursement program fund shall must be used by the
- 6 department of corrections to reimburse counties for housing and
- 7 custody of convicted felons pursuant to under the requirements of
- 8 section 35 of chapter IX of the code of criminal procedure, 1927 PA
- 9 175, MCL 769.35. The money in the secondary road patrol and
- 10 training fund shall must be used for secondary road patrol and
- 11 traffic accident **prevention** grants <del>pursuant to under</del> section 77 of
- 12 1846 RS 14, MCL 51.77, and for grants under section 14 of the
- 13 Michigan commission on law enforcement standards act, 1965 PA 203,
- 14 MCL 28.614. The department of state police and the department of
- 15 corrections shall report annually to the legislature all revenues
- 16 received and disbursed under this section.
- 17 (3) Each year the legislature shall appropriate to the
- 18 secondary road patrol and training fund an amount sufficient to
- 19 ensure that the amount deposited into the secondary road patrol and
- 20 training fund is not less than the amount deposited in the fiscal
- 21 year ending September 30, 2021.
