A bill to amend 1954 PA 116, entitled "Michigan election law,"

(MCL 168.1 to 168.992) by adding section 931b.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 931b. (1) An individual shall not intimidate an election official.
- 3 (2) An individual shall not prevent an election official from4 performing his or her duties.
- 5 (3) An individual who violates subsection (1) or (2) is guilty

- of a misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment for not more than 90 days or a fine of not more than \$500.00, or both.
- 3 (4) As used in this section:
- 4 (a) "Election official" means a public officer or public
 5 employee who has a duty to perform in connection with an election
 6 conducted under this act.
- 7 (b) "Intimidate" means to commit harassing conduct that would 8 cause a reasonable individual to feel terrorized, frightened, 9 threatened, harassed, or molested and that actually causes the 10 individual to feel terrorized, frightened, intimidated, threatened, 11 harassed, or molested.
