## **HOUSE BILL NO. 5310**

September 21, 2021, Introduced by Reps. LaFave and Markkanen and referred to the Committee on Transportation.

A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled "The Michigan penal code,"

by amending section 552c (MCL 750.552c), as added by 2005 PA 305.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 552c. (1) A person An individual shall not intentionally
- 2 and without authority or permission enter or remain in or upon
- 3 premises or a structure belonging to another person that is a key
- 4 facility if the key facility is completely enclosed by a physical
- 5 barrier of any kind, including, but not limited to, a significant

- 1 water barrier that prevents pedestrian access, and is posted with
- 2 signage as prescribed under subsection (2). As used in this
- 3 subsection, "key facility" means 1 or more of the following:
- 4 (a) A chemical manufacturing facility.
- 5 (b) A refinery.
- 6 (c) An electric utility facility, including, but not limited
- 7 to, a power plant, a power generation facility peaker, an electric
- 8 transmission facility, an electric station or substation, or any
- 9 other facility used to support the generation, transmission, or
- 10 distribution of electricity. Electric utility facility does not
- 11 include electric transmission land or right-of-way that is not
- 12 completely enclosed, posted, and maintained by the electric
- 13 utility.
- 14 (d) A water intake structure or water treatment facility.
- 15 (e) A natural gas utility facility, including, but not limited
- 16 to, an age station, compressor station, odorization facility, main
- 17 line valve, natural gas storage facility, or any other facility
- 18 used to support the acquisition, transmission, distribution, or
- 19 storage of natural gas. Natural gas utility facility does not
- 20 include gas transmission pipeline property that is not completely
- 21 enclosed, posted, and maintained by the natural gas utility.
- (f) Gasoline, propane, liquid natural gas (LNG), or other fuel
- 23 terminal or storage facility.
- 24 (g) A transportation facility, including, but not limited to,
- 25 a port, railroad switching yard, or trucking terminal.
- 26 (h) A pulp or paper manufacturing facility.
- 27 (i) A pharmaceutical manufacturing facility.
- 28 (j) A hazardous waste storage, treatment, or disposal
- 29 facility.

- 1 (k) A telecommunication facility, including, but not limited2 to, a central office or cellular telephone tower site.
- 3 (l) A facility substantially similar to a facility, structure,
  4 or station listed in subdivisions (a) to (k) or a resource required
  5 to submit a risk management plan under 42 USC 7412(r).
- 6 (m) The Mackinac Bridge.
- 7 (n) The Houghton-Hancock Bridge, also known as the Portage 8 Lake Lift Bridge.
- 9 (2) A key facility shall must be posted in a conspicuous
  10 manner against entry. The minimum letter height on the posting
  11 signs shall must be 1 inch. Each posting sign shall must be not
  12 less than 50 square inches, and the posting signs shall must be
  13 spaced to enable a person an individual to observe not less than 1
  14 posting sign at any point of entry upon the property.
- 15 (3) A person An individual who violates this section
  16 subsection (1) is guilty of a felony punishable by imprisonment for
  17 not more than 4 years 1 year or a fine of not more than \$2,500.00,
  18 \$5,000.00, or both.
- (4) An individual who violates subsection (1) with the intent to commit another felony within the key facility is guilty of a felony punishable by imprisonment for not more than 5 years or a fine of not more than \$25,000.00, or both.
- 23 (5) (4)—This section does not prohibit and shall be must not
  24 be construed to prevent lawful assembly or a peaceful and orderly
  25 petition for the redress of grievances, including, but not limited
  26 to, a labor dispute between an employer and its employees.
