## **HOUSE BILL NO. 5325**

September 22, 2021, Introduced by Rep. Green and referred to the Committee on Regulatory Reform.

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled "Michigan vehicle code,"

by amending sections 14, 248a, and 248d (MCL 257.14, 257.248a, and 257.248d), sections 14 and 248a as amended and section 248d as added by 2012 PA 498.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 14. (1) Except as provided in subsections (2), (3), and
- 2 (3), (4), "established place of business" means the place premises
- 3 actually occupied either continuously or at regular periods by a

- 12 any temporary quarters; the building or structure is continuously
- 13 occupied in good faith for the purpose of selling, buying, trading,
- 14 leasing, or otherwise dealing in motor vehicles; all books,
- 15 records, and files necessary to conduct the business of a class (a)
- 16 or class (b) dealer are maintained in the building or structure;
- 17 and the building or structure houses an office of at least 150
- 18 square feet in size, equipped with standard office furniture,
- 19 working utilities, a working restroom, and a working telephone
- 20 listed in the name of the business on the dealer's license.
- 21 (b) The premises have land space of no not less than 1,300
- 22 square feet to accommodate the display of a minimum of 10 vehicles
- 23 of the kind and type that the dealer is licensed to sell and an
- 24 additional 650 square feet for customer parking.
- 25 (c) The display and customer parking areas shall be described
- 26 in subdivision (b) are adequately surfaced and well-lit during
- 27 business hours.
- 28 (d) (c) The premises are identified by an exterior sign
- 29 displaying the name of the dealership that is permanently affixed

- to the building or land with letters clearly visible from  $\frac{a}{b}$ 1 2 highway.the roadway.
- (e) (d) The premises contain a conspicuous posting of the 3 dealer's regular hours of operation. The posted hours shall be must 4 5 not **be** less than 30 hours per week.
- 6 (f) (e) The premises contain a registered repair facility on 7 site for the repair and servicing of motor vehicles of a type sold 8 at the established place of business, unless the dealer has entered into a written servicing agreement with a registered repair 9 10 facility at a location not to exceed 10 miles' distance from that 11 is located within a 10-mile radius of the established place of 12 business. If repairs are conducted pursuant to under a servicing agreement, the dealer shall conspicuously post the servicing 13 14
- 15 (g) (f) The premises meet-satisfy all applicable zoning 16 requirements and any other applicable municipal requirements.

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(3) An established For a wholesaler, "established place of business for a wholesaler shall satisfy business" means premises that meet all of the following requirements:

- 3 displaying the name of the wholesaler that is permanently affixed
- 4 to the building or land with letters clearly visible from the

- 6 (e) The premises shall satisfy meet all applicable zoning
- 7 requirements and any other applicable municipal requirements.
- 8 (f) The premises contain a conspicuous posting of the
- 9 wholesaler's regular hours of operation.
- 10 (g) If a wholesaler receives its initial license on or after
- 11 January 1, 2022, the premises are not located within 200 feet of an
- 12 established place of business for another licensed wholesaler.
- 13 (4) For a used or secondhand vehicle parts dealer, vehicle
- 14 scrap metal processor, vehicle salvage pool operator, distressed
- 15 vehicle transporter, broker, and automotive recycler, "established
- 16 place of business" mean premises that meet all of the following
- 17 requirements:
- 18 (a) The premises contain a permanently enclosed building or
- 19 structure that is either owned, leased, or rented by the business
- 20 and that is not a commercial mailbox, tent, temporary stand, or
- 21 other temporary quarters.
- 22 (b) All books, records, and files necessary to conduct the
- 23 business of the dealer are maintained in the building or structure
- 24 described in subdivision (a).
- 25 (c) The premises are identified by an exterior sign displaying
- 26 the name of the dealer that is permanently affixed to the building
- 27 or land with letters clearly visible from the roadway.
- 28 (d) The premises meet all applicable zoning requirements and
- 29 any other applicable municipal requirements.

- 1 (e) The premises contain a conspicuous posting of the
- 2 business' regular hours of operation that include at least 15
- 3 regular business hours on a Monday through Saturday between the
- 4 hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. each week.
- 5 Sec. 248a. (1) A motor vehicle dealer shall not advertise or
- 6 represent a motor vehicle to be a demonstrator, executive or
- 7 manufacturer's vehicle, leased vehicle, new motor vehicle, or used
- 8 or secondhand vehicle unless the vehicle so described is as defined
- 9 in this act.
- 10 (2) A motor vehicle dealer shall maintain and adhere to
- 11 designated business hours that are filed with the secretary of
- 12 state.
- 13 (3) A class (a) or class (b) dealer shall maintain an
- 14 established place of business in this state in accordance with the
- 15 conditions listed in section 14(2).
- 16 (4) A class (a) or class (b) dealer shall maintain regular
- 17 business hours at an established place of business that include at
- 18 least 30 regular business hours on Monday through Saturday, between
- 19 the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. each week.
- 20 Sec. 248d. All of the following requirements apply to a
- 21 wholesaler:
- 22 (a) A wholesaler shall not advertise vehicles for sale on the
- 23 internet or any classified listing unless the advertisement clearly
- 24 discloses the wholesaler's license classification and clearly
- 25 states that any a purchaser shall must be a licensed vehicle
- 26 dealer.
- 27 (b) A wholesaler shall **not** buy or sell <del>not less fewer</del> than 24
- 28 vehicles in this state each year to retain possession of a
- 29 wholesaler license.

- (c) A wholesaler shall maintain an established place of
   business in this state that satisfies in accordance with the
- $\mathbf{3}$  conditions listed in section 14(3).
- 4 (d) A wholesaler shall maintain and adhere to designated5 business hours that are filed with the secretary of state.
- 6 (e) A wholesaler shall maintain regular hours of operation at
  7 an established place of business that include at least 15 regular
  8 business hours on a Monday through Saturday between the hours of
- 9 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. each week.
- 10 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days 11 after the date it is enacted into law.
