A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled "The Michigan penal code,"

(MCL 750.1 to 750.568) by adding section 81f.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 81f. (1) An individual who assaults, batters, wounds, or endangers a school employee, school contractor, member of a board of a public school or nonpublic school, member of the board of directors of a public school academy, or member of an intermediate school board who the individual knows or has reason to know is

- 1 performing his or her duties as a school employee, school
- 2 contractor, member of a board of a public school or nonpublic
- 3 school, member of the board of directors of a public school
- 4 academy, or member of an intermediate school board is guilty of a
- 5 misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment for not more than 1 year or
- 6 a fine of not more than \$1,000.00, or both.
- 7 (2) As used in this section:
- 8 (a) "Intermediate school board" means that term as defined in
- 9 section 4 of the revised school code, 1976 PA 451, MCL 380.4.
- 10 (b) "Nonpublic school" means that term as defined in section 5
- of the revised school code, 1976 PA 451, MCL 380.5.
- 12 (c) "Public school" means that term as defined in section 5 of
- 13 the revised school code, 1976 PA 451, MCL 380.5.
- 14 (d) "Public school academy" means that term as defined in
- 15 section 5 of the revised school code, 1976 PA 451, MCL 380.5.
- 16 (e) "School employee" means an individual who works at a
- 17 public school or nonpublic school.
- 18 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 19 after the date it is enacted into law.
