- 5 (b) The original application for benefits submitted by the 6 claimant.
- 7 (c) All amended applications for benefits submitted by the 8 claimant.

 - (2) Subsection (1) does not prohibit the unemployment agency from providing to an administrative law judge who conducts a hearing under this act an item not listed in subsection (1) that is related to the matter before the administrative law judge. If the unemployment agency violates subsection (1), the administrative law judge who conducts the hearing shall immediately notify the unemployment insurance citizens' advocate of the violation.
