- 2 (2) After reviewing a notice under subsection (1), the
- 3 attorney general shall participate, or if participation is not
- 4 automatically allowed, take all steps to participate, in any motion
- 5 or hearing on the approval of the attorney fees. In doing so, the
- 6 attorney general shall consider and advocate on behalf of the best
- 7 interests of the residents of this state who are class members and
- 8 shall state on the record whether the request for attorney fees
- 9 should be approved, rejected, or modified by the court.
- 10 (3) If the attorney general represents the state or any of its
- 11 departments or officers or another person in a class action to
- 12 which this section applies, the attorney general shall take all
