A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled "The Michigan penal code,"

by amending section 223 (MCL 750.223), as amended by 2012 PA 242.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 223. (1) A person who knowingly sells a pistol without complying with section 2 of 1927 PA 372, MCL 28.422, is guilty of a misdemeanor —punishable by imprisonment for not more than 90 days —or a fine of not more than \$100.00, or both.
- 5 (2) A person who knowingly sells a firearm more than 26 inches6 in length to a person under 18 years of age is guilty of a

- 1 misdemeanor —punishable by imprisonment for not more than 90 days
- 2 τ or a fine of not more than \$500.00, or both. A second or
- 3 subsequent violation of this subsection is a felony punishable by

- 5 \$2,000.00, or both. It is an affirmative defense to a prosecution
- 6 under this subsection that the person who sold the firearm asked to
