(2) Beginning March 1, 2022, a resident of this state who is 65 years of age or older may obtain a 7-day senior deer license. The fee for a 7-day senior deer license is \$12.00. The department may issue a kill tag with or as part of each 7-day senior deer license. The kill tag must bear the license number.
