A bill to amend 1953 PA 232, entitled "Corrections code of 1953,"

by amending section 37 (MCL 791.237), as amended by 2012 PA 24, and by adding section 65j.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 37. (1) When a prisoner is released upon on parole, the
- 2 department shall provide the prisoner with clothing and a
- 3 nontransferable ticket to the place in which where the paroled
- 4 prisoner is to reside. At the discretion of the deputy director in

- 6 repaid to the state by the paroled prisoner within 180 days after

- (d) A statement as to whether the prisoner was placed on parole or discharged upon completion of his or her sentence.
 - (5) The department shall provide a prisoner who menstruates with a 1-month supply of feminine hygiene products when the prisoner is released on parole or is released on the completion of the prisoner's maximum sentence. The department shall not charge a prisoner for feminine hygiene products provided or received under this subsection.
- (6) (5) The cost of implementing this section shall must bepaid out of the general fund of the state.
- 21 (7) As used in this section, "feminine hygiene product" means 22 a product used in connection with the menstrual cycle including, 23 but not limited to, tampons and sanitary napkins.
- Sec. 65j. (1) On the request of a prisoner in a correctional facility who menstruates, the department shall provide feminine hygiene products to that prisoner.
