## **HOUSE BILL NO. 5874**

March 03, 2022, Introduced by Reps. Markkanen, Marino and Borton and referred to the Committee on Military, Veterans and Homeland Security.

A bill to amend 1967 PA 150, entitled "Michigan military act,"

(MCL 32.501 to 32.851) by adding section 132a.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 132a. (1) Under the Michigan legislative state medal
- 2 program established under section 132, the legislature may award
- 3 the Michigan legislative medal of honor.
- 4 (2) The Michigan legislative medal of honor is the highest
- 5 legislatively issued military award of this state. All of the
- 6 following apply to the awarding of the medal:

- 1 (a) The medal may be awarded to a living or deceased service 2 member who satisfies any of the following requirements:
- 3 (i) Was born in this state.
- 4 (ii) Was a resident of this state when the service member 5 entered military service.
- 6 (iii) Died in this state.
- 7 (b) The medal must be awarded to a service member who
- 8 voluntarily performs a deed of personal bravery or self-sacrifice
- 9 involving risk of life that is so conspicuous as to clearly
- 10 distinguish the service member for gallantry and intrepidity above
- 11 the service member's comrades. Awarding of the medal must be
- 12 determined in accordance with the standard of extraordinary merit.
- 13 The medal may be awarded only on incontestable proof of performance
- 14 of the deed.
- 15 (c) The legislative council administrator shall submit the
- 16 following information to the chairpersons of the house of
- 17 representatives and senate committees that have responsibility for
- 18 military and veterans affairs:
- 19 (i) If the legislative council administrator determines that a
- 20 nominee does not qualify for the medal, the name of the nominee and
- 21 the reasons why the nominee does not qualify for the medal.
- 22 (ii) If the legislative council administrator determines that a
- 23 nominee qualifies for the medal and recommends the nominee for the
- 24 medal, his or her recommendation, the nomination, and any
- 25 supporting documents.
- 26 (d) The legislature may award the medal by concurrent
- 27 resolution. The legislature shall not, during a single regular
- 28 session, award the medal to more than the following 2 individuals:
- 29 (i) One service member who served between January 1, 1836 and

- 1 December 31, 1955.
- 2 ( $\ddot{u}$ ) One service member who served on or after January 1, 1956.
- 3 (e) Upon passage of the concurrent resolution described in
- 4 subdivision (d), the speaker of the house of representatives and
- 5 the majority leader of the senate shall award the medal in the
- 6 presence of the legislator or legislators who sponsored the
- 7 concurrent resolution and the representative and senator of the
- 8 district where the individual being awarded the medal resides or
- 9 last resided.
- 10 (f) If the legislature determines that a recommendation does
- 11 not meet the standards for awarding the medal, the legislature may
- 12 determine that the recommendation meets the standards for the
- 13 Michigan legislative medal of valor under section 132b.
- 14 (3) As used in this section:
- 15 (a) "Legislative council administrator" means the council
- 16 administrator appointed by the legislative council under section
- 17 104a of the legislative council act, 1986 PA 268, MCL 4.1104a, or
- 18 his or her designee.
- 19 (b) "Medal" means the Michigan legislative medal of honor
- 20 described in subsection (1).
- 21 (c) "Service member" means a member or former member of the
- 22 state military establishment, another state's military
- 23 establishment, or the United States Armed Forces.
- 24 (d) "United States Armed Forces" means the United States Army,
- 25 Navy, Marine Corps, Air Force, or Coast Guard, including the
- 26 reserve components.
- 27 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect
- 28 unless all of the following bills of the 101st Legislature are
- 29 enacted into law:
