- 2 (ii) A working paper.
- 3 (iii) A statement contained in a report or working paper.
- 4 (2) The confidentiality provided under subsection (1) is not 5 waived by the presence of another individual that is necessary to 6 effectuate the communication.
- 7 (3) As used in this section:
- 8 (a) "Confidential communication" means information transmitted 9 in connection with the rendering of crisis intervention, advice, 10 counseling, or other assistance that is 1 of the following:
- 11 (i) Between a victim of human trafficking and human trafficking 12 victim service agency staff.
- 13 (ii) Between a victim of human trafficking or human trafficking
 14 victim service agency staff and any other individual to whom
 15 disclosure is reasonably necessary to further the interests of the
 16 victim.
 - (b) "Human trafficking victim service agency staff" means an individual who is employed by or who volunteers services for a human trafficking victim support agency, and who in that capacity provides advice, supportive services, crisis intervention, advocacy, or other assistance to victims of human trafficking.
- (c) "Human trafficking victim support agency" means an office, refuge, shelter, safe house, institution, agency, center, or other entity that offers assistance to victims of human trafficking and their families through crisis intervention, shelter, advocacy, legal, supportive counseling, or similar service.
- 27 (d) "Victim of human trafficking" means an individual who was 28 or who alleges to have been the subject of human trafficking as 29 described in chapter LXVII or LXVIIA of the Michigan penal code,
