## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 234d. (1) Except as provided in subsection (2), a person
- 2 shall not possess a firearm on the premises of any of the

- 4 (a) A depository financial institution or a subsidiary or
- 5 affiliate of a depository financial institution.

- 17 (c) A person licensed by this state or another state to carry18 a concealed weapon.
- (d) A person who possesses a firearm on the premises of an
  entity described in subsection (1) if that possession is with the
  permission of the owner or an agent of the owner of that entity.
  - (3) Except as provided in subsection (4), a person shall not, while the polls are open on an election day, possess a firearm in a polling place or within 100 feet from any entrance to a building in which a polling place is located.
  - (4) Subsection (3) does not apply to a uniformed law enforcement officer acting in the course of his or her duties.
- (5) (3) A person who violates this section is guilty of a
   misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment for not more than 90 days or
