## **HOUSE BILL NO. 5993**

April 12, 2022, Introduced by Reps. Weiss, Kuppa, Brabec, Rogers, Breen, Sowerby, Sneller, Brixie, Stone, Cavanagh, Hope, Brenda Carter, LaGrand and Young and referred to the Committee on Education.

A bill to amend 1937 (Ex Sess) PA 4, entitled

"An act relative to continuing tenure of office of certificated teachers in public educational institutions; to provide for probationary periods; to regulate discharges or demotions; to provide for resignations and leaves of absence; to create a state tenure commission and to prescribe the powers and duties thereof; and to prescribe penalties for violation of the provisions of this act,"

by amending section 3a of article II and section 3 of article III (MCL 38.83a and 38.93), as amended by 2011 PA 101.
