A bill to amend 1966 PA 313, entitled

"An act to award tuition grants to resident students enrolled in independent nonprofit institutions of higher learning; and to make an appropriation therefor,"

by amending section 7 (MCL 390.997), as amended by 1980 PA 503.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 7. A student who receives a state competitive scholarship

authorized by Act No. 208 of the Public Acts of 1964, as amended,

is not eligible to receive a tuition grant concurrently. However,

the state competitive scholarship award of a student enrolled in an

independent nonprofit college or university may be increased with

- 1 funds from the tuition grant program under this act up to the level
- 2 of the maximum tuition grant award as provided in section 5, if the
- 3 maximum tuition grant award is greater than the maximum competitive
- 4 scholarship award in a given year.A student may receive a tuition
- 5 grant under this act concurrently with a state competitive
- 6 scholarship under 1964 PA 208, MCL 390.971 to 390.981. However, the
- 7 total amount awarded to a student receiving concurrent awards under
- 8 this section must not exceed the amount of the student's tuition
- 9 and fees for the full academic year as reported by the college or
- 10 university in which the student is enrolled.
