## **HOUSE BILL NO. 6105**

May 18, 2022, Introduced by Reps. Hauck and Steenland and referred to the Committee on Regulatory Reform.

A bill to amend 1998 PA 58, entitled "Michigan liquor control code of 1998,"

(MCL 436.1101 to 436.2303) by adding sections 609g, 609h, and 609i.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 609g. (1) If a wholesaler sells nonalcoholic beverages to
- 2 a retailer, this act does not apply to the sale, marketing,
- 3 merchandising, or distribution of the nonalcoholic beverages except
- 4 the following:
- 5 (a) The wholesaler shall comply with section 609.

- 1 (b) The wholesaler shall not do either of the following:
- 2 (i) Provide free nonalcoholic beverages products to a retailer.
- 3 (ii) Provide credit to a retailer.
- 4 (2) If a wholesaler separately owns or has a direct or
- 5 indirect financial interest in a company, this act does not apply
- 6 to the company if all of the following conditions are met:
- 7 (a) The company is not a wholesaler.
- 8 (b) The company and the wholesaler have separate sales and
- 9 delivery employees.
- 10 (c) The company and the wholesaler use separate delivery
- 11 vehicles.
- 12 (d) The company and the wholesaler keep separate finances.
- 13 (e) The company does not engage in an activity on behalf of
- 14 the wholesaler that would violate section 609.
- 15 (3) If a wholesaler owns or has a direct or indirect financial
- 16 interest in a company, the wholesaler and the company may do all of
- 17 the following:
- 18 (a) Share human resources departments.
- 19 (b) Have a joint payroll.
- 20 (c) Lease warehouse space to each other.
- 21 (d) Have joint vehicle maintenance.
- 22 (e) Jointly recycle beverage containers.
- 23 (f) Share warehouse and personal equipment.
- 24 Sec. 609h. A manufacturer or supplier may offer electronic
- 25 rebate coupons directly to a retail customer after the retail
- 26 customer purchases alcoholic liquor from a retailer. An electronic
- 27 rebate coupon issued under this subsection must comply with all the
- 28 following:
- 29 (a) A manufacturer or supplier shall only issue coupons that

- state a specific expiration date and specific cash refund value on the coupons.
- 3 (b) A manufacturer or supplier shall not issue coupons that
  4 result in the retail customer's purchase of alcoholic liquor being
  5 below the retailer's cost.
- 6 (c) A manufacturer or supplier may issue coupons that can be
  7 applied to more than 1 specific product sold by that manufacturer
  8 or supplier but must state the manufacturer or supplier to which
  9 they apply.

- (d) A manufacturer or supplier shall issue coupons that require the retail customer to purchase at least 1 product of alcoholic liquor to redeem a coupon. A manufacturer or supplier may issue coupons that require the retail customer to purchase 2 or more alcoholic liquor products from the same manufacturer or supplier to redeem the coupon.
- 16 (e) A manufacturer or supplier shall not issue coupons that 17 require the purchase of a product other than alcoholic liquor.
  - (f) A wholesaler shall not pay for or participate in the offering of coupons except for providing signs that promote the electronic rebate coupon in accordance with section 610a.
- 21 (g) A manufacturer shall only issue coupons that may be 22 redeemable after a purchase of alcoholic liquor at all retail 23 locations where that alcoholic liquor is sold.
- Sec. 609i. If demands exceed supply for a beer, wine, mixed wine drink, or mixed spirit drink product, a manufacturer, supplier, or wholesaler must do both of the following:
- 27 (a) Engage in commercially reasonable efforts to make the 28 beer, wine, mixed wine drink, or mixed spirit drink product 29 available to purchase by a wholesaler that places an order.

(b) Engage in commercially reasonable efforts to make the 1 2 beer, wine, mixed wine drink, or mixed spirit drink product 3 available to purchase by a retailer that places the order. 4 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect unless all of the following bills of the 101st Legislature are 5 enacted into law: 6 (a) Senate Bill No. or House Bill No. 6106 (request no. 7 8 05815'22). (b) Senate Bill No. \_\_\_\_ or House Bill No. 6107 (request no. 9 10 06255'22).
