A bill to amend 2012 PA 392, entitled
"Municipal lighting authority act,"
(MCL 123.1261 to 123.1295) by adding section 32.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 32. (1) If a local government possesses stranded assets
2 that adversely affect the reliability and resilience of an electric
3 utility, the legislature shall grant full or partial relief for
4 their removal. The legislature shall fund the full or partial
5 relief from the infrastructure investment and jobs act, Public Law

1 117-58, or any other applicable source.

2 (2) As used in this section, "stranded assets" means local
3 assets not accounted for in the plan submitted by the board under
4 section 17 that are associated with the decommissioning of
5 dangerous or obsolete infrastructure that impacts public safety,
6 electric service resilience or reliability, or the creation of
7 blight.
