A bill to prohibit local governments from decriminalizing public indecency; and to provide for the powers and duties of certain state and local governmental officers and entities.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. As used in this section:
- (a) "Decriminalize" means to repeal a local ordinance or
 charter provision or to lessen the penalties of violating a local
 ordinance or charter provision from criminal to civil.
- (b) "Local government" means a county, city, township, orvillage.

- (c) "Public indecency law" means any law that penalizes public
 urination, public defecation, or littering.
- Sec. 3. (1) If a local government has a local ordinance or
 charter provision to provide for criminal penalties for violating a
 public indecency law, the local government shall not decriminalize
 public indecency.
- 7 (2) If a local government decriminalized public indecency
 8 after January 1, 2022, the local government shall, no later than 60
 9 days after the effective date of this act, reenact the public
 10 indecency ordinance as it was on January 1.
