HOUSE BILL NO. 6424

September 28, 2022, Introduced by Rep. Hornberger and referred to the Committee on Commerce and Tourism.

A bill to prohibit the sale, offering for sale, and distribution for sale of certain disposable wipes without a warning label; to require that certain wipes be marketed as nonflushable; and to prohibit certain acts and provide civil sanctions.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. As used in this act:
- 2 (a) "Disposable wipe" means a nonflushable, nonwoven
- 3 disposable wipe that is premoistened and constructed from nonwoven
- 4 sheets and designed and marketed for diapering, personal hygiene,

- 1 or household hard-surface cleaning purposes. A disposable wipe does
- 2 not include a wipe product designed or marketed for cleaning or
- 3 medicating the anorectal or vaginal areas on the human body and is
- 4 labeled "flushable", "sewer safe", "septic safe", or is otherwise
- 5 labeled to indicate that the product is appropriate for disposal in
- 6 a toilet, including, but not limited to, premoistened toilet
- 7 tissue.
- 8 (b) "Label" means a display of written, printed, or graphic
- 9 matter on the principal display panel of a disposable wipe and
- 10 includes the requirements imposed under this act.
- 11 (c) "Principal display panel" means the side of a product
- 12 package that is most likely to be displayed, presented, or shown
- 13 under customary conditions of display for retail sale. Principal
- 14 display panel includes the following:
- 15 (i) In the case of a cylindrical or nearly cylindrical package,
- 16 the surface area of the principal display panel constitutes 40% of
- 17 the product package, as measured by multiplying the height of the
- 18 container by the circumference.
- 19 (ii) In the case of a flexible film package, in which a
- 20 rectangular prism or nearly rectangular prism stack of wipes is
- 21 housed within the film, the surface area of the principal display
- 22 panel constitutes the length times the width of the side of the
- 23 package when the flexible packaging film is pressed flat against
- 24 the stack of wipes on all sides of the stack.
- Sec. 3. A disposable wipe sold, offered for sale, or
- 26 distributed for sale in this state must include 1 of the following
- 27 labels prominently displayed in a conspicuous location on the
- 28 principal display panel of the disposable wipe package:
- 29 (a) "NONFLUSHABLE.".

- 1 (b) "DO NOT FLUSH.".
- 2 Sec. 5. Disposable wipes marketed in this state must be
- 3 clearly marketed as nonflushable.
- 4 Sec. 7. (1) A person that violates this act is subject to a
- 5 civil fine as follows:
- 6 (a) For a first offense, a civil fine of not more than
- 7 \$2,000.00.
- 8 (b) For a second offense, a civil fine of not more than
- 9 \$5,000.00.
- 10 (c) For a third or subsequent offense, a civil fine of not
- **11** more than \$10,000.00.
- 12 (2) A violation of this act may be prosecuted by the
- 13 prosecutor of the county in which the violation occurred, or by the
- 14 attorney general.
