November 09, 2022, Introduced by Rep. Steven Johnson and referred to the Committee on Natural Resources and Outdoor Recreation.

A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled "Natural resources and environmental protection act," by amending section 80205 (MCL 324.80205), as amended by 2018 PA 237; and to repeal acts and parts of acts.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 80205. (1) A person is not required to wear a personal
- 2 flotation device to operate, ride on, or be towed by a personal
- 3 watercraft, and any state or local law, including a rule or order,
- 4 providing otherwise is invalid and unenforceable. A person shall
- 5 not operate a personal watercraft on the waters of this state
