A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled "The Michigan penal code,"

(MCL 750.1 to 750.568) by adding section 410c.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 410c. (1) A person shall not distribute, deliver, sell, or possess with intent to distribute, deliver, or sell a drug masking product.
- 4 (2) Except as provided in subsection (3), a person who
 5 violates this section is guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by

- 1 imprisonment for not more than 1 year or a fine of not more than
- 2 \$1,000.00, or both.
- 3 (3) A person who violates this section for commercial purposes
- 4 is quilty of a felony punishable by imprisonment for not more than
- 5 years or a fine of not more than \$5,000.00, or both.
- 6 (4) As used in this section:
- 7 (a) "Commercial purposes" means an activity undertaken with
- 8 the purpose of providing a product for monetary compensation.
- 9 (b) "Drug masking product" includes synthetic urine, human
- 10 urine, a substance designed to be added to human urine, or a
- 11 substance designed to be added to or used on human hair or oral
- 12 fluid, for the purpose of defrauding an alcohol or a drug screening
- 13 test.
- 14 (c) "Synthetic urine" means a substance that is designated to
- 15 simulate the composition, chemical properties, physical appearance,
- 16 or physical properties of human urine.
