## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 4gg. (1) The tax under this act does not apply to the 2 storage, use, or consumption of personal protective equipment.
- 3 (2) The tax under this act does not apply to machinery or 4 equipment that is used by the purchaser to manufacture or produce 5 personal protective equipment.
- 6 (3) As used in this section, "personal protective equipment"

- 1 means items for human wear and designed as protection of the wearer
- 2 against injury or disease or as protection against damage or injury
- 3 of other persons or property but not suitable for general use.
- 4 Personal protective equipment includes, but is not limited to,
- 5 breathing masks, face shields, respirators, protective gloves, and
- 6 safety glasses and goggles.
- 7 Sec. 4hh. (1) The tax under this act does not apply to the
- 8 storage, use, or consumption of disinfecting products.
- 9 (2) As used in this section, "disinfecting products" means
- 10 products designed to disinfect or sanitize an individual,
- 11 workplace, or personal protective equipment as that term is defined
- 12 in section 4gg. Disinfecting products includes, but is not limited
- 13 to, antibacterial soap, disinfecting spray, disinfecting wipes, and
- 14 hand sanitizer.
