THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 29e. (1) If a public record contains material that is not
- 2 exempt under section 29d, as well as material that is exempt from
- 3 disclosure under section 29d, the public body shall separate the
- 4 exempt and nonexempt material and make the nonexempt material
- 5 available for examination and copying.

- 1 (2) When designing a public record, a public body shall, to
- 2 the extent practicable, facilitate a separation of exempt from
- 3 nonexempt information. If the separation is readily apparent to a
- 4 person requesting to inspect or receive copies of the form, the
- 5 public body shall generally describe the material exempted unless
- 6 that description would reveal the contents of the exempt
- 7 information and thus defeat the purpose of the exemption.
- 8 Sec. 29f. The attorney general shall counsel and advise a
- 9 public body on the administration of this part upon request.
- 10 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect January
- **11** 1, 2022.
- 12 Enacting section 2. This amendatory act does not take effect
- 13 unless Senate Bill No. 234 of the 101st Legislature is enacted into
- **14** law.
