

SENATE BILL NO. 244

March 16, 2021, Introduced by Senator RUNESTAD and referred to the Committee on Judiciary and Public Safety.

A bill to amend 1961 PA 236, entitled
"Revised judicature act of 1961,"
by amending section 1910 (MCL 600.1910), as amended by 1994 PA 403.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 1910. (1) Proof of service ~~shall~~**of process may** be made
2 by 1 of the following methods:

3 (a) Written acknowledgment of **the** receipt of a summons and a
4 copy of the complaint, dated and signed by the person authorized
5 under this act to receive them.

6 (b) A certificate, stating the facts of service, if service is

1 made ~~within the~~ **in this** state ~~of Michigan~~ by **any of the following:**

2 (i) A sheriff.

3 (ii) A deputy sheriff, medical examiner, ~~bailiff,~~ **court**
4 **officer, or** constable, or a deputy of **any of** these officers, if the
5 officers held office in a county in which the court issuing the
6 process is held.

7 (c) ~~An affidavit, stating the facts of service, if~~ **If** service
8 is made by any other ~~person, and indicating his or her official~~
9 ~~capacity, if any individual, a written statement of the facts of~~
10 **service, verified by the following statement: "I declare under the**
11 **penalty of perjury that this proof of service has been examined by**
12 **me and that its contents are true to the best of my information,**
13 **knowledge, and belief."**

14 (2) Failure to make proof of service does not affect the
15 validity of the service.

16 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 180 days
17 after the date it is enacted into law.
