THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1280h. (1) The superintendent of public instruction shall
- 2 appoint 7 members to an advisory committee within the department
- 3 that shall aid the department in developing or adopting and
- 4 updating the resource guide described in section 1280i(13). The
- 5 advisory committee must consist of the following 7 members:

- 1 (a) One member with experience working in the field of 2 dyslexia intervention, as determined by the superintendent of 3 public instruction, who is employed by the department or an entity 4 that represents the interests of school board members or school
- 6 (b) One member from an institution of higher education with
 7 expertise in dyslexia screening and interventions and who is
 8 conversant in current research related to dyslexia, as determined
 9 by the superintendent of public instruction.

- 10 (c) Two members who are or have been employed by a school
 11 district, intermediate school district, or public school academy
 12 and who have expertise in dyslexia screening and interventions, as
 13 determined by the superintendent of public instruction.
- 14 (d) One member who is an individual with a dyslexia diagnosis
 15 or is the parent or legal guardian of an individual with a dyslexia
 16 diagnosis.
- 17 (e) One member who is a speech-language pathologist with 18 expertise in the characteristics of dyslexia and structured 19 language and literacy.
- 20 (f) One member who is selected from a list of 2 or more
 21 nominees submitted by an individual who represents the interests of
 22 the Michigan Association of School Psychologists and who has
 23 expertise in the characteristics of dyslexia and structured

- 25 (2) As used in this section, "dyslexia" and "structured 26 language and literacy" mean those terms as defined in section 27 1280i.
