- 4 quilty of first degree murder and shall be punished by imprisonment
- 5 for life without eligibility for parole:

- (a) Murder perpetrated by means of poison, lying in wait, or
 any other willful, deliberate, and premeditated killing.
- (b) Murder committed in the perpetration of, or attempt to 3 perpetrate, arson, criminal sexual conduct in the first, second, or 4 5 third degree, child abuse in the first degree, a major controlled 6 substance offense, robbery, carjacking, breaking and entering of a 7 dwelling, home invasion in the first or second degree, larceny of 8 any kind, extortion, kidnapping, vulnerable adult abuse in the 9 first or second degree under section 145n, torture under section 10 85, aggravated stalking under section 411i, or unlawful
 - (c) A murder of a peace officer or a corrections officer committed while the peace officer or corrections officer is lawfully engaged in the performance of any of his or her duties as a peace officer or corrections officer, knowing that the peace officer or corrections officer is a peace officer or corrections officer engaged in the performance of his or her duty as a peace officer or corrections officer.
 - (2) A person must be committed to the jurisdiction of the department of corrections for incarceration in a state correctional facility pending sentencing and immediately following a conviction under this section.
