- 1 before January 1, 2009, 10%.
- 2 (b) For tax years that begin after December 31, 2008 and
- **3** before January 1, 2012, 20%.
- 4 (c) For tax years that begin after December 31, 2011 and
- 5 before January 1, 2021, 6%.
- 6 (d) For the 2021 tax year, 7%.
- 7 (e) For the 2022 tax year, 8%.
- 8 (f) For the 2023 tax year, 9%.
- 9 (g) For the 2024 tax year and each tax year after 2024, 10%.
- 10 (2) If the credit allowed by this section exceeds the tax
- 11 liability of the taxpayer for the tax year, the state treasurer
- 12 shall refund the excess to the taxpayer without interest, except as
- 13 provided in section 30 of 1941 PA 122, MCL 205.30.
