SENATE BILL NO. 473

May 25, 2021, Introduced by Senator VICTORY and referred to the Committee on Judiciary and Public Safety.

A bill to amend 1965 PA 203, entitled "Michigan commission on law enforcement standards act," (MCL 28.601 to 28.615) by adding section 11a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 11a. (1) No later than 120 days after the effective date of the amendatory act that added this section, the commission shall develop guidelines for the investigation of officer-involved deaths that involve a law enforcement officer licensed under this act.
- 5 (2) The commission shall do all of the following:
- 6 (a) Ensure that the guidelines are easily accessible and

- 1 publicly available on its website.
- 2 (b) Send a copy of its guidelines to all law enforcement
- 3 agencies in this state.
- 4 (c) Review and update the guidelines as it considers
- 5 necessary.
- 6 (3) Not later than 120 days after receipt of the guidelines
- 7 from the commission, each law enforcement agency shall create a
- 8 written policy regarding the investigation of officer-involved
- 9 deaths that involve a law enforcement officer employed by the law
- 10 enforcement agency. A written policy created pursuant to this
- 11 subsection must meet the requirements set forth in the commission's
- 12 quidelines.
- 13 (4) Each law enforcement agency shall submit the written
- 14 policy created pursuant to subsection (3) to the commission for
- 15 review and approval.
- 16 (5) If the commission approves a law enforcement agency's
- 17 written policy, the law enforcement agency shall do all of the
- 18 following:
- 19 (a) Give a copy of its policy to a law enforcement officer in
- 20 its employ.
- 21 (b) Reproduce the policy in an electronic or digital format
- 22 that is easily accessible to the public.
- (c) Post a copy of the policy on its website.
- 24 (6) As used in this section:
- 25 (a) "Guidelines" means the guidelines for the investigation of
- 26 officer-involved deaths developed by the commission under
- 27 subsection (1).
- 28 (b) "Officer-involved death" means the death of an individual
- 29 caused directly by an action or an omission of a law enforcement

- 1 officer while the law enforcement officer is on duty or while the
- 2 law enforcement officer is off duty but performing activities that
- 3 are within the scope of his or her law enforcement duties.
