A bill to amend 1933 PA 167, entitled "General sales tax act," $(MCL\ 205.51\ to\ 205.78)\ by\ adding\ section\ 4\emph{ll}.$

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 4*ll*. Beginning 90 days after the effective date of the amendatory act that added this section through December 31, 2021, a sale of firearm safety devices is exempt from the tax under this act. Upon the retail sale or transfer of a firearm, the seller shall provide a written notice to the purchaser and shall post in a conspicuous manner at all points of sale on the premises where

- 1 firearms are sold a notice that says the following: "The state of
- 2 Michigan has exempted the sale of firearm safety devices from the
- 3 sales and use tax imposed by this state through December 31,
- 4 2021.". As used in this section, "firearm safety devices" means
- 5 safes, lock boxes, trigger and barrel locks, and other items
- 6 designed to enhance home firearm safety.
- 7 Enacting section 1. The legislature shall annually appropriate
- 8 sufficient funds from the state general fund to the state school
- 9 aid fund created in section 11 of article IX of the state
- 10 constitution of 1963 to fully compensate for any loss of revenue to
- 11 the state school aid fund resulting from the enactment of this
- 12 amendatory act.
