September 01, 2021, Introduced by Senators LASATA and VICTORY and referred to the Committee on Judiciary and Public Safety.

A bill to amend 2004 PA 177, entitled "Michigan law enforcement officers memorial act," by amending section 4 (MCL 28.784).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 4. (1) The Michigan law enforcement officers memorial
- 2 monument fund commission is created as a type II agency in the
- 3 department of management and budget. The commission is the
- 4 governing body of the monument fund. The commission shall consist
- 5 consists of all of the following:

- 1 (a) The state treasurer or his or her designee.
- 2 (b) The attorney general or his or her designee.
- 3 (c) Five members appointed by the governor as follows:
- 4 (i) One member who is a police chaplain who has 5 or more5 years' experience as a police chaplain.
- 6 (ii) One member nominated by the Michigan state troopers
 7 association who is a survivor of an officer of the Michigan state
 8 police killed while on duty.
- 9 (iii) One member nominated by the executive director of the 10 sheriff's association of Michigan who is a survivor of an officer 11 of a county sheriff's department killed while on duty.
- (*iv*) One member nominated by the chief of police of a municipal police department of a municipality with a population of more than 500,000 who is a survivor of an officer of that police department killed while on duty.
- 16 (ν) One member nominated by the executive director of the
 17 Michigan fraternal order of police who is a survivor of an officer
 18 killed while on duty who served with a municipal police department
 19 of a municipality with a population of 500,000 or less.
- 20 (d) One member appointed by the senate majority leader.
- 21 (e) One member appointed by the speaker of the house of 22 representatives.

(2) Members A member of the commission appointed under subsection (1)(c), (d), or (e) shall serve for terms a term of 4 years or until a successor is appointed, whichever is later. If a vacancy occurs on the commission, the vacancy shall must be filled in the same manner as the original appointment. The governor may remove a member of the commission for incompetency, dereliction of duty, malfeasance, misfeasance, or nonfeasance in office, or any

- 1 other good cause.
- 2 (3) The commission shall initially convene within 6 months
- 3 after the first deposit of money in the monument fund. The
- 4 commission shall meet often enough to expedite the completion of
- 5 the monument as prescribed in section 5. At the first meeting, the
- 6 commission shall elect from among its members a chairperson and
- 7 other officers as it considers necessary or appropriate. A majority
- 8 of the members of the commission constitute a quorum for conducting
- 9 business.
- 10 (4) The commission shall conduct its business at public
- 11 meetings held in compliance with the open meetings act, 1976 PA
- 12 267, MCL 15.261 to 15.275. A writing prepared, owned, used, in the
- 13 possession of, or retained by the commission in the performance of
- 14 an official function shall must be available to the public in
- 15 compliance with the freedom of information act, 1976 PA 442, MCL
- **16** 15.231 to 15.246.
- 17 (5) Members A member of the commission shall serve without
- 18 compensation. However, members a member of the commission may be
- 19 reimbursed for their his or her actual and necessary expenses
- 20 incurred in the performance of their his or her official duties as
- 21 members a member of the commission.
