

SENATE BILL NO. 667

September 30, 2021, Introduced by Senators IRWIN and CHANG and referred to the Committee on Judiciary and Public Safety.

A bill to amend 2006 PA 563, entitled
"An act to restrict the use and disclosure of certain statements
made by law enforcement officers,"
by amending section 1 (MCL 15.391), as amended by 2016 PA 302.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. As used in this act:
- 2 (a) "Involuntary statement" means **truthful** information
- 3 provided by a law enforcement officer, if compelled under threat of
- 4 dismissal from employment or any other employment sanction, by the
- 5 law enforcement agency that employs the law enforcement officer.

1 (b) "Law enforcement agency" means the department of state
2 police, the department of natural resources, or a law enforcement
3 agency of a county, township, city, village, airport authority,
4 community college, or university, that is responsible for the
5 prevention and detection of crime and enforcement of the criminal
6 laws of this state.

7 (c) "Law enforcement officer" means all of the following:

8 (i) A person who is trained and licensed or certified under the
9 Michigan commission on law enforcement standards act, 1965 PA 203,
10 MCL 28.601 to 28.615.

11 (ii) A local corrections officer as defined in section 2 of the
12 local corrections officers training act, 2003 PA 125, MCL 791.532.

13 (iii) An emergency dispatch worker employed by a law enforcement
14 agency.

15 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
16 after the date it is enacted into law.
