October 26, 2021, Introduced by Senators MCBROOM, OUTMAN, BUMSTEAD, MACDONALD, DALEY, BIZON and SCHMIDT and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

A bill to make, supplement, and adjust appropriations for various state departments and agencies for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2022; to provide for certain conditions on appropriations; and to provide for the expenditure of the appropriations.

PROVISIONS CONCERNING APPROPRIATIONS

GENERAL SECTIONS

18 Sec. 201. Pursuant to section 30 of article IX of the state
19 constitution of 1963, total state spending from state sources under
20 part 1 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2022 is \$0.00 and
21 total state spending from state sources to be paid to local units
of government is \$0.00.

23 Sec. 202. The appropriations made and expenditures authorized
24 under this part and part 1 and the departments, commissions,
25 boards, offices, and programs for which appropriations are made
26 under this part and part 1 are subject to the management and budget
act, 1984 PA 431, MCL 18.1101 to 18.1594.

28 Sec. 203. If the state administrative board, acting under
29 section 3 of 1921 PA 2, MCL 17.3, transfers funds from an amount
appropriated under this act, the legislature may, by a concurrent

1 resolution adopted by a majority of the members elected to and
2 serving in each house, inter-transfer funds within this act for the
3 particular department, board, commission, office, or institution.

5 **DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES**

6 Sec. 301. From the funds appropriated in part 1 for Northern
7 Michigan tourism and sports fund, \$30,000,000.00 is designated as a work
8 project appropriation for a grant program for infrastructure and events
9 supporting Michigan recreation, sports, and tourism. Not less than 50%
10 annually shall be spent on grants awarded to Upper Peninsula projects. Any
11 unencumbered or unallotted funds allocated pursuant to this section shall
12 not lapse at the end of the fiscal year and shall be available for
13 expenditure for projects under this section until the projects have been
14 completed. The following is in compliance with section 451a of the
15 management and budget act, 1984 PA 431, MCL 18.1451a:

16 (a) The purpose of the work project is to support Michigan
17 recreation, sports, and tourism.

18 (b) The work project will be accomplished by grants for
19 infrastructure and events supporting Michigan recreation, sports, and
20 tourism.

21 (c) The total estimated cost of the work project is \$30,000,000.00.

22 (d) The tentative completion date is September 30, 2026.
