A bill to amend 1976 PA 388, entitled "Michigan campaign finance act,"

by amending section 45 (MCL 169.245), as amended by 1996 PA 590.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 45. (1) A person may transfer any unexpended funds from 1
- 2 candidate committee to another candidate committee of that person
- 3 if the contribution limits prescribed in section 52 or 69 for the

- 1 candidate committee receiving the funds are equal to or greater
- 2 than the contribution limits for the candidate committee
- 3 transferring the funds and if the candidate committees are
- 4 simultaneously held by the same person. The funds being transferred
- 5 shall not be considered a qualifying contribution regardless of the
- 6 amount of the individual contribution being transferred.
- 7 (2) Upon termination of a candidate committee, unexpended
- 8 funds in the candidate committee that are not eligible for transfer
- 9 to another candidate committee of the person under subsection (1)
- 10 shall be disbursed as follows:
- 11 (a) Given to a political party committee.
- 12 (b) Given to a tax exempt charitable organization, as long as
- 13 the candidate does not become an officer or director of or receive
- 14 compensation, either directly or indirectly, from that
- 15 organization.
- 16 (c) Returned to the contributors of the funds upon termination
- 17 of the campaign committee.
- 18 (d) If the person was a candidate for the office of state
- 19 representative, given to a house political party caucus committee.
- (e) If the person was a candidate for the office of state
- 21 senator, given to a senate political party caucus committee.
- 22 (f) Given to an independent committee.
- 23 (g) Given to a ballot question committee.
- 24 (h) Given to the contaminated site cleanup contingency reserve
- 25 fund created in section 1016 of article 4 of 2021 PA 87 or any
- 26 other state fund whose purpose is to address cleanup of
- 27 contaminated sites.
