A bill to create the Great Lakes maritime office and prescribe its powers and duties; to allow the provision of grants and other financial and technical assistance related to port facilities; and to provide the powers and duties of certain state governmental officers and entities.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. This act may be cited as the "Great Lakes maritime

- 6 (b) Perform the duties described in the Great Lakes maritime7 grant program act.
- 8 (2) The department shall appoint a full-time director of the
- 9 office, and provide the office with appropriate staff support and
- 10 resources. The director's sole responsibility under this act is to
- 11 carry out the duties of the office as described in this act and the
- 12 Great Lakes maritime grant program act.
