SENATE BILL NO. 823

January 19, 2022, Introduced by Senator IRWIN and referred to the Committee on Environmental Quality.

A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled "Natural resources and environmental protection act," (MCL 324.101 to 324.90106) by adding section 61506e.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 61506e. (1) Subject to subsections (2) and (3), a person
- 2 shall not operate an oil or gas well except in conjunction with a
- 3 methane control or capture system capable of reducing fugitive
- 4 methane emissions by 99%. This subsection does not apply to a well
- 5 that consists only of a wellhead.

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- 1 (2) Subsection (1) applies beginning on the date rules are
- 2 promulgated under subsection (7). However, if a permit was issued
- 3 for an oil or gas well under section 61525 before the date rules
- 4 are promulgated under subsection (7), subsection (1) applies to
- 5 that well according to the schedule described in subsection (7)(b).
- 6 (3) The operator of an oil or gas well shall not use flaring
- 7 as a method to control methane emissions.
- 8 (4) Subject to subsection (6), if an operator violates
- 9 subsection (1), both of the following apply:
- 10 (a) The operator shall be ordered to pay a civil fine of
- 11 \$100,000.00.
- 12 (b) If the operator fails to first comply with subsection (1)
- 13 by 180 days after the date when subsection (1) first applies to the
- 14 well, as provided by subsection (2), the supervisor shall revoke
- 15 the operator's permit for the well.
- 16 (5) Subject to subsection (6), if an operator violates
- 17 subsection (3), both of the following apply:
- 18 (a) The operator shall be ordered to pay a civil fine of
- 19 \$100,000.00.
- 20 (b) The supervisor shall revoke the operator's permit for the
- 21 well.
- 22 (6) Subsections (4) and (5) do not apply if the methane
- 23 control or capture system malfunctioned and the operator promptly
- 24 repaired the system.
- 25 (7) Within 180 days after the effective date of this section,
- 26 the supervisor shall promulgate rules to implement this section. At
- 27 a minimum, the rules shall provide for all of the following:
- 28 (a) The specific types of methane capture and control systems
- 29 that may be used to comply with this section.

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- 1 (b) A schedule for the operator of an oil or gas well to 2 comply with this section and the rules if a permit was issued for 3 the well before the date the rules are promulgated.
- 4 (c) Procedures and schedules for inspections by the supervisor 5 to verify compliance with this section and the rules.
- 6 (d) Procedures for operators to report compliance with this 7 section and the rules.
- 8 (e) Procedures and schedules for maintenance and performance
 9 testing of a methane control or capture system required under
 10 subsection (1).
- 11 (f) Requirements for the prompt repair of a malfunctioning 12 methane control or capture system required under subsection (1).
- Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days after the date it is enacted into law.
