January 20, 2022, Introduced by Senator LASATA and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

A bill to amend 1979 PA 94, entitled "The state school aid act of 1979,"

by amending sections 236 and 241 (MCL 388.1836 and 388.1841), as amended by 2021 PA 86.
